

Preschool Curriculum Outline

We wanted to share with you the overall requirements and material that we will be teaching your child. Please feel free to go over the list and practice anything you can with your child at home. This can easily be made into games and will provide your child with the extra support needed to master all of these skills by the end of the year!

Please note that we are a cycle. This information is introduced in K4 and they have until the end of K5 to *master* (*) this knowledge.

Concepts/items covered by preschool

- Student will be able to give the following information orally:
 - First name
 - Full Name
 - Age
 - Address
 - Birth Date
 - Telephone Number

- Student will be able to identify the following body parts:
 - Heels
 - Ankles
 - Jaw
 - Shoulders
 - Elbows
 - Hips
 - Wrists
 - Waist

- Student will be able to:
 - Stand on one foot for 10 seconds
 - Stand on the other foot for 10 seconds
 - Stand on one foot momentarily with eyes closed
 - Stands on other foot momentarily with eyes closed
 - Walks backward toe-to-heel four steps

- Student will be able to identify the following colors:
 - Red
 - Blue
 - Green
 - Yellow
 - Orange
 - Purple
 - Brown
 - Black
 - Pink
 - Gray

- Student will be able to draw a person including the following body parts
 - Head
 - Legs
 - Ears
 - Arms
 - Trunk
 - Eyes
 - Nose
 - Neck
 - Hands
 - Mouth

- Student will be able to recognize and name all 26 upper-case and lower-case letters of the alphabet as well as name the sound and a word associated with each letter.

- Student will be able to print the following information
 - First Name

- Last Name
- Student will be able to match, join groups and count numbers up to 30
- Healthy Lifestyle
 - Yoga/ self-regulation
 - Explores different ways of moving
 - Healthy eating
 - Personal self-care
 - Relaxation
 - Autonomy/ independence
- Motor Skills
 - Fine Motor Skills (Writing, cutting, coloring).
 - Gross Motor Skills (body awareness)
- Social Skills and Confidence
- Introduction to reading and writing
